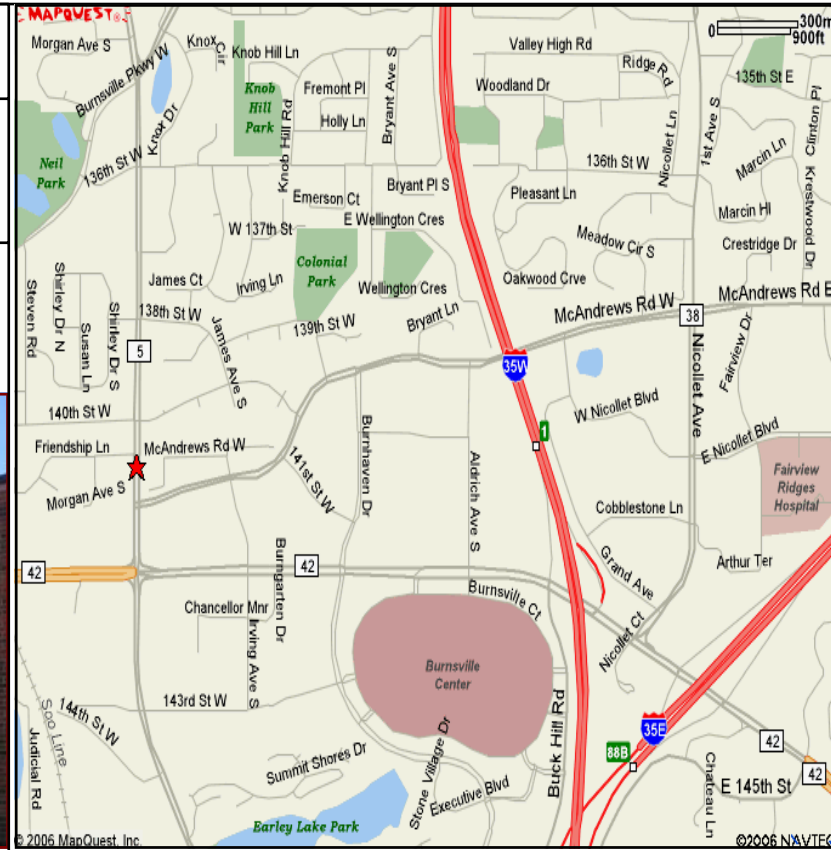

## The Angelic Shout...

## A Day for Friends...

When the morning stars sang together, and all the sons of God shouted for joy? Job 38:7

The phrase *shouted for joy* in this verse is actually a single word in the Hebrew, *ruva*. This word carries a number of meanings. However, it is most frequently translated *shout!* When the army of Joshua surrounded Jericho it *shouted*, and the walls fell down, Joshua 6:20. In Psalm 100:1, *ruva* is translated, *Make a joyful noise*. It can refer to a shout of alarm, a shout of triumph or a shout of joy. But it always refers to a loud shout.

In fact, it comes from a root meaning to *split*. This sound would be as a noise that would split eardrums or shatter glass.

In the context of Job 38, the Lord is reminding Job and his friends of the great event of creation. When the earth, which is destined to house God's throne in the eternal ages to come, was established on solid foundations or on the third day of Creation, a resounding noise like mighty thunder or, better, a gigantic angelic anthem echoed throughout the universe.

An innumerable company of angels, Hebrews 12:22, is identified in the poetic structure of the Hebrew parallelism in our text. As both *morning stars* and *sons of God*, shouted and sang in unison when the solid earth appeared.

It is quite probable that the angels were created on the first day of creation, immediately after the creation of the universe. Even though Satan and other angels later rebelled against God, most of the angels still obey Him, and one day, we will actually hear them singing His praises and shouting for joy when He returns to earth. I Thessalonians 4:16 & 18 says, *For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and the trump of God; and the dead in Christ shall rise first...Wherefore, comfort one another with these words.*

Therefore, *Praise ye Him all His angels: praise ye Him, all His hosts*, Psalm 148:2. Someday, we shall join them in a *joyful noise* at God's throne.

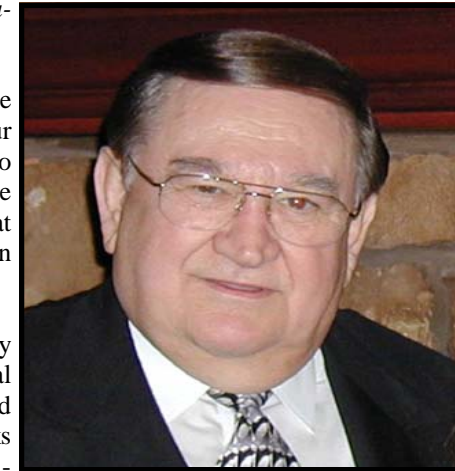
We all have much to do and our lives are always so busy. I trust you have not been so busy that you have not taken time to be thankful.

We usually take time at each meal to bow our heads and give audible thanks for our present provision be it our daily bread, in private, at a family meal, or in public at a restaurant.

This is biblical as Jesus Christ set the example Himself. When He miraculously fed the multitude beside the Sea of Galilee, He began with a prayer of thanksgiving: *The Scripture says: He took the seven loaves and the fishes, and gave thanks, and brake them. . . . And they did all eat, and were filled,* Matthew 15:36-37.

It is good to give thanks for our food and shelter and clothing, but the blessing of having Christian friends is

even more thankworthy. The first letter to the Thessalonians was possibly

our prayers, *I Thessalonians 1:2...*

We give thanks to God always for you all, making mention of you in our prayers, *I Thessalonians 1:2...*

Paul's first Spirit-inspired letter to Christian friends, and Paul began with a testimony of thankfulness to God for them .

When Paul wrote to the Philippians, he began similarly: *I thank my God upon every remembrance of you*, Philippians 1:3.

And to the Colossians, Paul continued: We give thanks to God and the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, praying always for you, Colossians 1:3.

church at Corinth: I thank you God always on your behalf, for the grace of God which is given you by Jesus Christ, I Corinthians 1:4.

Throughout our Christian life journey we develop lasting Christian friends, and can thank God for all of them. What a blessing to have such friends, and how fitting it is to give God special thanks for them.

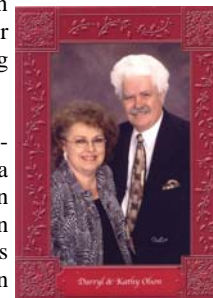
Chet will be addressing our first afternoon session of A Day With Friends.
